Rules and Regulations for Bay City Western Aesthikos Chapter of National Honor Society

1. Attendance - Monthly meetings are **mandatory** (morning as well as afternoon meetings are offered) Any absence must be due to Extenuating Circumstances as outlined in the BCPS attendance policy. Consequences for absence
 - a. 1st absence: warning
 - b. 2nd absence: meeting scheduled with FAC and may be removed from NHS

1. Member Requirements - Volunteer hours (**3 projects + 3 additional NHS hours**)
 - a. 3 Projects: You will need to participate in 1 Blood Drive, 1 Highway Clean-Up, and the Dodgeball tournament (or 2, one hour sessions of tutoring in the Math Lab)
 - b. 3 Additional NHS hours: Ex: Math Lab tutoring, Blood Drive Sign-Up, etc.
 - c. Requirements must be completed prior to Spring Break 2019.
 - i. Exception would be hours obtained in the final Spring HW cleanup
 - ii. Hours must be completed and documented through turning in gold sheets to your officers by Spring Break 2019 to maintain membership status.

****NHS graduation stoles will not be issued until all service requirements have been met.****

2. Grounds for Dismissal - (Dismissals are recommended by the Faculty Advisory Committee.)
 - a. Any violation of school or athletic code of conduct
 - b. Any documented illegal misconduct
 - c. Failure to meet NHS attendance requirement
 - d. Failure to complete and/or report the volunteer hours requirement on time
 - e. A GPA falling below the minimum requirement of 3.50

(To appeal a dismissal, a student must schedule a meeting with the Faculty Advisory Committee (FAC) within one week of notification. A final ruling will be determined by the FAC.)
